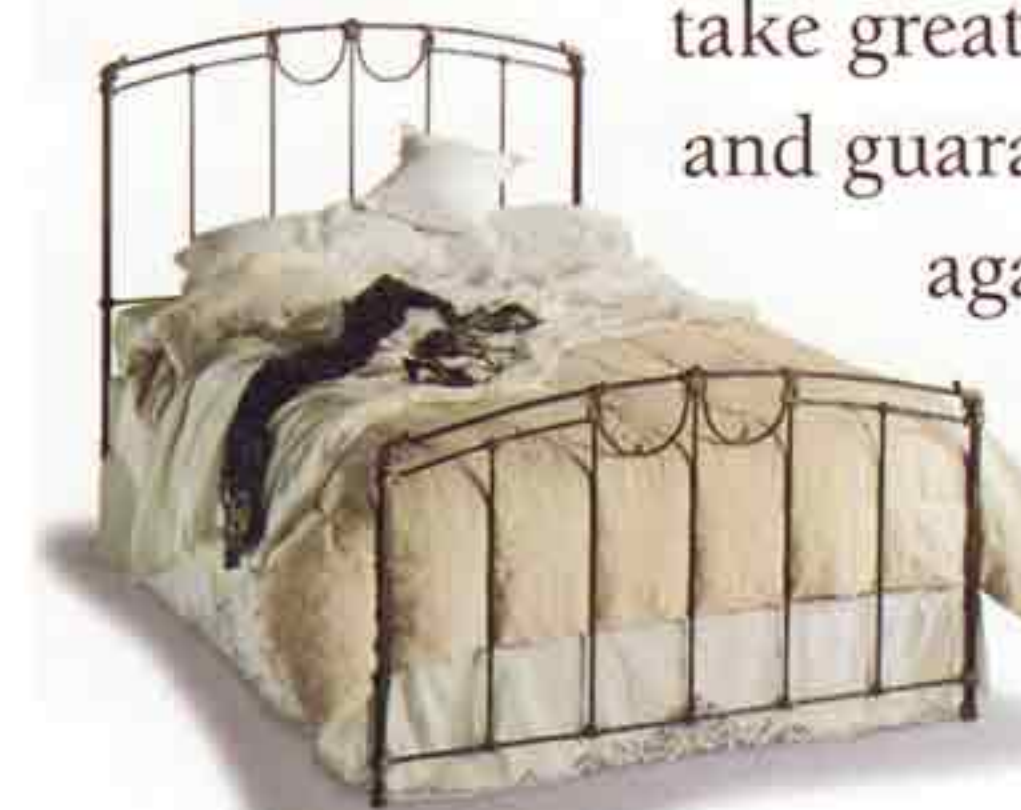
Delivery

Rail system: Our interlocking, easy-to-assemble design ensures a strong & sturdy bed.

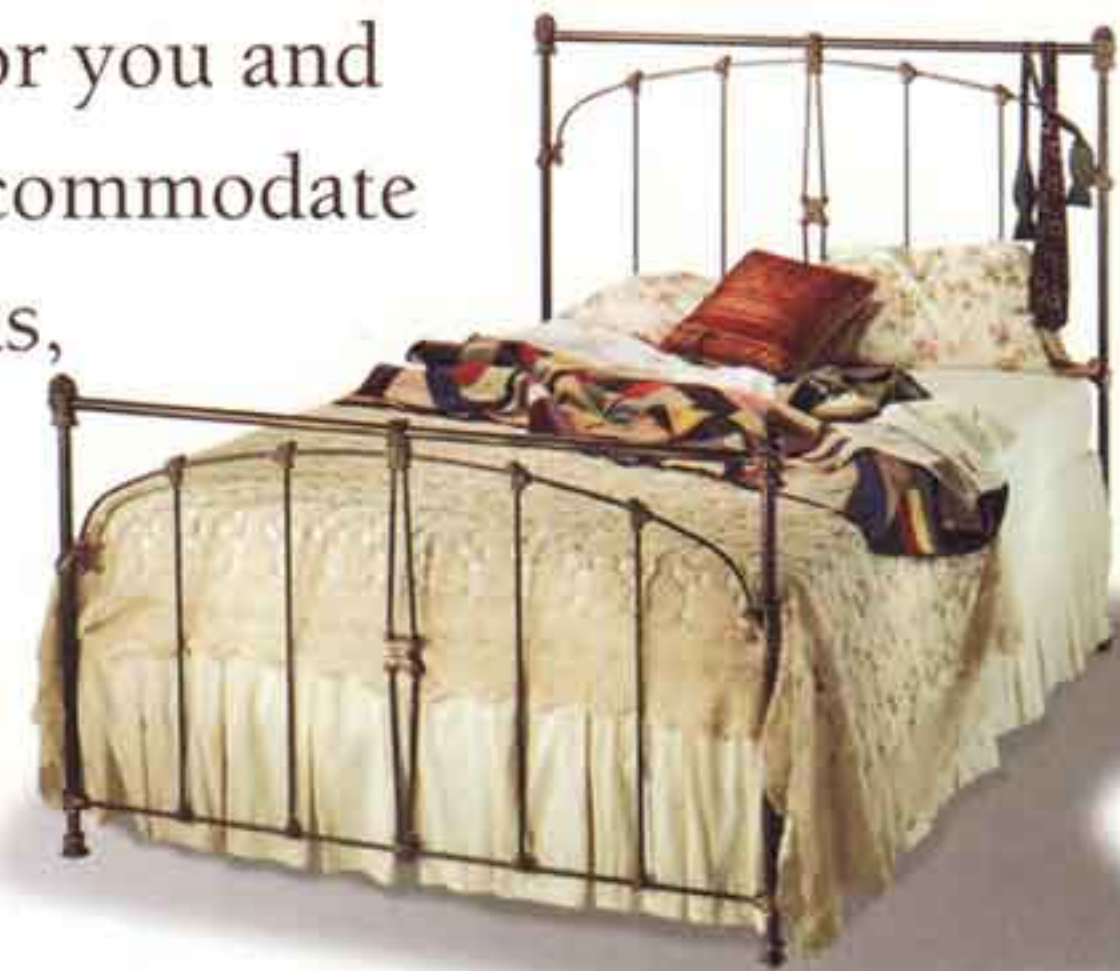

Strength: We use heavy gauge steel tubing and cold-rolled solid bar stock for extra strength. Our brass beds use 18-gauge solid brass tubing with steel reinforced side posts.
